

## **Family Legal Planning Checklist**

 Will (Designates guardian and distributes assets to trust.)
 <b>Trust</b> (Prevents children from receiving full access to inheritance at age 18, maintains privacy, and allows trustee to allocate trust funds according to children's needs.)
 <b>Standby Guardianship Document</b> (Designates guardian in the event of your incapacity.)
 <b>Power of Attorney</b> (Authorizes designated person to manage your family's finances in the event you are incapacitated.)
 <b>Healthcare Proxy</b> (Authorizes designated person to make medical decisions for you in the event you are incapacitated.)
 <b>Beneficiary Designations</b> (Assign beneficiary designations to align with overall estate plan.)
 <b>Inventory of Assets</b> (Ensures all your assets will be preserved and transferred to your family.)
 <b>List of Digital Assets with Passwords</b> (Ensures your digital assets will be accessible to your family.)
 <b>Letter to Trustee</b> (Provides guidance to trustee on how you'd like funds to be used.)
 <b>Letter to Guardian</b> (Provides important information about your children, such as doctors's info, medical issues, allergies, etc. and guidance in raising your children, e.g., religious upbringing, family traditions, public or private education.)
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
